

- **1.2** Selected candidates of other universities are to submit their Inter University Migration certificate before the date prescribed by the University. In the absence of migration certificate, admission will be provisional and at the risk and responsibility of the candidate.

3. HOUSE TESTS

3.1 College shall hold at least two house tests usually in October and March. A candidate who obtains less than 40% marks in each theory paper & 40% in practical shall not allowed to appear in University exam.

4. DISCIPLINE

4.1 During the period of training the student must not attend or take part in any anti-government, anti college or subversive activities. Extreme penalty for such activities is expulsion and forfeiture of character certificate.

4.2 B.Ed is a full time course and the candidates preparing for B.Ed. examination are not allowed to take up any job during the period of training. In case candidate is detected to have been on active service during the

period of training, his admission will be cancelled and he/ she will have to leave the college immediately.

4.3 At any time during the course of training the Principal may on the advice of staff, drop from the rolls of the college a student who does not abide by the college discipline or debar him/ her from participation in activities.

4.4 Certificate may be withheld in case of misconduct, irregular attendance and unsatisfactory progress in studies or non-payment of dues.

4.5 A student adjudged by the Principal to be guilty of a serious offence forfeits his/her claim of any certificate, honour and distinction otherwise due to him.

4.6 No Public recognition will be given to the students who violate college discipline or not showing good behavior.

4.7 Students (Boys and Girls) should come to the college in teacher like dress. Girls are not allowed Jeans, Skirts, Sleeveless Shirts, Mini, Middies etc.

5. FACILITIES.

5.1 Audio- Visual : The college has its own Computers (30), Scanner, Printer, LAN and broadband Internet for unlimited use, tape Recorders, Overhead Projectors, Television, Cameras, VCD, LCD, Slide Projector etc. Students will be provided firsthand experience of the devices frequently. 5.2 Instructional Material Center: The center is located in a separate room. 8.2 If a student remains absent from his classes for a continuous period of seven days without level, his name shall be struck off form the rolls. He may be allowed re admission accordance with the rules.

<u>9. LIBRARY</u>

The college has rapidly growing library, nearly 7600 books and subscribes to 35 Educational Journals and newspapers. Pupil teachers are expected to make full use of the same.

- 1.1 Two books for a period of fortnight will be issued to pupil teacher on his non transferable Library cum identity card. A duplicate card may obtained on payment of Rs. 20/- in case of loss.
- 1.2 A book borrowed from the library will have to be returned to the library on due dated. Defaulters are liable to fine of Rs. 5.00 per day per volume.
- 1.3 Reference books and current periodicals are not issued for taking out of library.
- 1.4 Book Bank: There are about 800 books in the book bank that are issued to the students for the whole of the year and till the examination are over.

11.FEES

Fees for B.Ed.Two Year is **Rs.60,000+60000.** Fee prescribed by the authorities only will be charged.

Fees for D.El.Ed.Two Year is Rs.40,000+40000 for students admitted through center counseling and Rs.44000+44000 for students admitted through counseling by the college as per GOVT rules. Fee prescribed by the authorities only will be charged.

12.DMCS & DEGREES

After the result of B.Ed /D.El.Ed., DMCs and degrees of B.Ed are to be issued only to candidates. Don't send relatives. Even in exceptional emergency, the student sending father or brother must send request cum authority letter attesting the signature of the bearer. Students may inquire about degrees in May of the next year.

13.COLLEGE CAMPUS & BUILDING

The college is located in pollution free zone on Hanumangarh Road, Near B.S.F. It is housed in a modern building consisting of spacious classrooms, well equipped laboratories, well stocked Library. The college has spacious playgrounds and lawns where facilities for playing different games are available.

15.CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION
