

HOUSE TESTS

Colleges shall hold at least two house tests usually in October and March. A candidate who obtains less than 40% marks in each theory paper & 40% in practical shall not allowed to appear in University exam.

FACILITIES.

<u>Audio- Visual:</u> The College has its own Computers (27), Scanner, Printer, LAN and broadband Internet for unlimited use, tape Recorders, Overhead Projectors, Television, Cameras, VCD, LED (2), LED Projectors (2) and Slide Projector etc. Students will be provided firsthand experience of the devices frequently.

<u>Instructional Material Centre</u>: The centre is located in a separate room. It has a collection of teaching aids of all types. The aids are issued for use during teaching practice.

DISCIPLINE

- 1. During the period of training the student must not attend or take part in any antigovernment, anti college or subversive activities. Extreme penalty for such activities is expulsion and forfeiture of character certificate.
- 2. B.Ed. is a full time course and the candidates preparing for B.Ed. examination are not allowed to take up any job during the period of training. In case candidate is detected to have been on active service during the period of training, his admission will be cancelled and he/ she will have to leave the college immediately.
- 3. At any time during the course of training the Principal may on the advice of staff, drop from the rolls of the college a student who does not abide by the college discipline or debar him/ her from participation in activities.
- 4. Certificate may be withheld in case of misconduct, irregular attendance and unsatisfactory progress in studies or non-payment of dues.
- 5. A student adjudged by the Principal to be guilty of a serious offence for feats his/her claim of any certificate, honour and distinction otherwise due to him.
- 6. No Public recognition will be given to the students who violate college discipline or not showing good behavior.
- 7. Students (Boys and Girls) should come to the college in teacher like dress. Girls are not allowed Skirts, Sleeveless Shirts, Mini, Middies etc.




